The 21-22 school year was a 'return to the new normal'. The Booster Club continually planned and worked to be more creative in the ways that we impact the students, staff, and overall Fife High community. Through the continued generosity of its members, donors, and countless volunteers; the Booster Club provided more than \$78,000 in support of students, staff, and alumni.

Boosters have an impact on our school!

September

- Provided funding for upgraded signage around the stadium in the amount of \$600.10.
- Provided breakfast boxes/coffee to staff on the 181st day in the amount of \$264.75.

October

- Provided funding for Hall of Fame recognition, Homecoming promotional items, and Homecoming 5th Quarter entertainment totaling \$2367.23.
- Funded \$489.60 for the football team dinner prior to the Homecoming game.
- Provided funding to the wrestling team for the purchase of new uniforms in the amount of \$3629.72.

November

- Provided funding for the TDM Hollywood trip in the amount of \$800 (\$100/student)
- Provided funding for a playoff football team dinner in the amount of \$658.74.
- Sponsored scholarships for students from the FHS Scholarship Foundation totaling \$5100.

December

 Sponsored the John McCrossin Memorial Basketball Classic and provided funding to TDM (\$1000), paid costs of the Classic, provided funding for the purchase of new C/JV basketball uniforms, and provided funding to the FHS Scholarship Foundation (\$4500), Shulapalooza (\$1387), and Mesothelioma Research (\$1364) for a grand total of \$19,875.43.
