Jerry opened his optometry office in August of 1972 and is still serving the community 43 years later. Jerry's mother graduated from Fife in 1938 and his 2 sons also graduated from Fife. He has been a contributing member of the Fife/Milton community his entire adult life. Like his father, Jerry served on the Fife School Board from 1974 to 1983. Among many other activities, Jerry was a member of the Fife Rotary for 30 years and a contributing member of the Fife High School Scholarship Foundation.



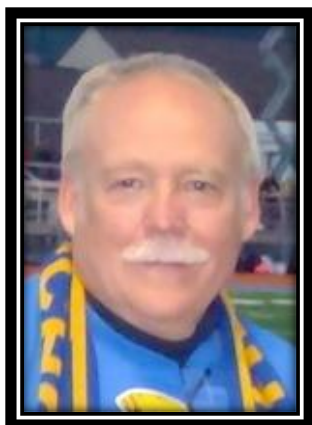
Philip Waldner

Phil graduated in the Class of 1976. Born and raised in Fife, Phil worked at the family business, Fife Towing, just like his father and grandfather before him. Today, Phil, brother Kenton, and son Jason continue to build this 4th generation Fife business and have been serving the community since 1949. Phil went on to Pacific Lutheran University earning his Bachelor's and Master's degrees in education. Phil has served on the Fife Regional Chamber of Commerce Board for 20 years and has been president 3 times so far. Phil has also been a major contributor to FBLA and the Fife High School Scholarship Foundation for 20 years.



Angela Jensen

Angela graduated in the Class of 2007. As a student-athlete, Angela earned 7 varsity letters – 3 in volleyball, 1 in basketball, and 3 in track. As a sprinter, Angela was named 1st team all-league in each of her 3 years. As a junior, Angela was the State 3A Champion in the 100 meter dash and the 300 meter hurdles. She also was 2nd in the 100 meter hurdles. In her senior year, Angela did not lose a single race. She was State Champion in the 100 meter dash, the 300 meter hurdles, and the 100 meter hurdles where she set a new 2A State record of 14.3 – the best time of every classification and still the best 2A time ranking her in the top 1% in the nation. To date, Angela is the most decorated track athlete at Fife High School.



Jeff Jensen

Jeff graduated in the Class of 1973. He became a volunteer fire fighter for the Fife Fire Department in 1974. Jeff was hired as a full time fire fighter in 1977. During his 40 year career, he worked his way to Deputy Chief and retired from the fire department in 2013. Jeff's parents both graduated from Fife in 1947 and 2 of his children also graduated from Fife. Jeff is a life-long resident of the District and lives in a house built by his grandfather in Fife Heights. He continues to serve the community as a liaison for Fire District 10 which includes Fife and Fife Heights.



Vince Strojan

Vince graduated in the Class of 1964. Vince was the career scoring and rebounding leader when he graduated and helped his team place 7th in the Class A State Basketball Tournament. Vince turned down offers to play at Division 1 schools and joined his brother at St. Martin's College. Once again, Vince was the all-time leading scorer and rebounder when he graduated from St. Martin's – earning a tryout with the Seattle Supersonics. He married his high school sweetheart, Sandy Olson, and moved onto the family farm in Fife, staying there from 1978 until 2003. They raised 4 boys who all attended Fife. Vince served as president of the Booster Club from 1988 to 1990 and has been a strong supporter of Fife High School.
